# **Ukraine Credit Union Displacement Fund**

Report - February 2023

#### CONTEXT



Russia's full-scale war against Ukraine starting on February 24, 2022, has had a devastating impact on Ukraine and by extension, its credit union system, members and communities.

In response, on February 27, 2022, the Worldwide Foundation for Credit Unions launched its Ukrainian Credit Union Displacement Fund.
